\*  $\mathbf{x}$  $\bigstar$ **The Cracked Pot**  $\frac{1}{2}$ ☆ A water bearer in India had two large pots, each hung on the ends of a  $\bigstar$ 

★ pole that he carried across his neck. One of the pots had a crack in it,  $\star$  while the other pot was perfect and always delivered a full portion of ☆ water.

☆  $\mathbf{x}$ At the end of the long walk from the stream to the house, the cracked ☆  $\stackrel{\frown}{\propto}$ pot arrived only half full. For a full two years this went on daily, with the  $\stackrel{\frown}{\sim}$ bearer delivering only one and a half pots full of water to his house.  $\bigstar$ ☆

 $\star$  Of course, the perfect pot was proud of its accomplishments, perfect  $\star$  for which it was made. But the poor cracked pot was ashamed of its  $\star$  own imperfection and miserable that it was able to accomplish only  $\bigstar$ half of what it had been made to do.  $\frac{1}{2}$ 

\* After two years of what it perceived to be a bitter failure, it spoke to the  $\mathbf{x}$ water bearer one day by the stream. "I am ashamed of myself, and I  $\stackrel{\frown}{\propto}$ want to apologise to you. I have been able to deliver only half my load  $\bigstar$ because this crack in my side causes water to leak out all the way  $\frac{1}{2}$ back to your house. Because of my flaws, you have to do all of this  $\frac{1}{2}$ work, and you don't get full value from your efforts," the pot said. ☆

 $\overrightarrow{}$ The bearer said to the pot, "Did you notice that there were flowers on  $\frac{1}{2}$ your side of the path but not on the other pot's side? That's because I  $\frac{1}{2}$ have always known about your flaw, and I planted flower seeds on  $\bigstar$ ★ your side of the path. Every day while we walk back, you've watered them. For two years, I have been able to pick these beautiful flowers to  $\stackrel{\frown}{\sim}$  $\stackrel{\frown}{\propto}$ decorate the table. Without you being just the way you are, there  $\stackrel{\frown}{\sim}$ would not be this beauty to grace the house."  $\frac{1}{2}$


# Welcome to Our Service
