 \bigstar In several New Testament passages the Christian is urged to give time to prayer. In Luke 18, Jesus taught a parable to demonstrate that people \bigstar "always ought to pray and not lose heart" (Luke 18:1). Threat to Cameroon

Statistically, Cameroon is a majority-Christian country, but violent Boko Haram forces have advanced across the border from Nigeria with the aim of taking over the far northern region and combining it with northern Nigeria and other parts of West Africa to form an Islamic caliphate.

People have been killed, villages burned, homes looted, livestock killed and food supplies destroyed. The UN estimates that 170,000 people, mostly Christians, have fled the violence, seeking refuge in mountain hideouts or larger 'safe' towns.
