The Blessings Of Prayer



★ One of the greatest blessings a child of God has is prayer, the right to communicate with God. Anyone who is striving to do the will of the Lord will have an active prayer life.

★ Give Yourself to Prayer

★ In several New Testament passages the Christian is urged to give time to prayer. In Luke 18, Jesus taught a parable to demonstrate that people "always ought to pray and not lose heart" (Luke 18:1). The apostle Paul, in 1 Timothy 2:8, encouraged men in every place to pray.

**In 1 Thessalonians 5:17 Christians are commanded to
"Pray without ceasing."**

★ To "pray without ceasing" is not to have some incessant babbling on your lips but to have the attitude of mind to regularly and frequently pray. It means to have a willingness to talk to God—to share burdens, to confess sins and to pray for strength and courage.

★ Why emphasize prayer? James 5:16 gives the answer: "...The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much." It works! 1 Peter 3:11-12 states that "the eyes of the Lord are on the righteous and His ears are open to their prayers." He hears and answers in accordance with His will if the Christian prays in faith (James 1:6).

★ Make your life a life of prayer. If you are going to be truly like Jesus, it will be. Jesus was a man of prayer. He recognized its vital role.

Threat to Cameroon

Statistically, Cameroon is a majority-Christian country, but violent Boko Haram forces have advanced across the border from Nigeria with the aim of taking over the far northern region and combining it with northern Nigeria and other parts of West Africa to form an Islamic caliphate.

People have been killed, villages burned, homes looted, livestock killed and food supplies destroyed. The UN estimates that 170,000 people, mostly Christians, have fled the violence, seeking refuge in mountain hideouts or larger 'safe' towns.
