\checkmark "But God is my helper" (Psalm 54:4).

★ Have you ever looked up the phrase "but God" in the Bible? You'll find it ☆ \bigstar ☆ in a lot of interesting situations where God intervened. \checkmark ☆

★ Take the story of Noah, for example. I wonder if he started to lose hope * as he and his family bobbed around in that ark with all those animals * after the Flood. Genesis 8:1 tells us, "But God remembered Noah and \star all the wild animals and livestock with him in the boat. He sent a wind to \bigstar blow across the earth, and the floodwaters began to recede". \bigstar

★ Then we have the story of Joseph. His brothers sold him into slavery and * thought he was dead. Yet God preserved him. He elevated Joseph to a \star position of great power in which he was in charge of the food supply. \bigstar

🔆 When a famine struck, his brothers appeared before him one day, asking ☆ ★ for food. Joseph said to them, "You intended to harm me, but God ★ intended it all for good. He brought me to this position so I could save the Δ \star lives of many people" (Genesis 50:20).

 \mathbf{x} The nation of Israel faced the Red Sea-an insurmountable obstacle- $\frac{1}{2}$ 🔆 with the Egyptian army in hot pursuit. But God intervened. And what ★ looked like a hopeless situation became a time of glorious deliverance. ★ The Bible tells us, "But the people of Israel had walked through the ☆ middle of the sea on dry ground, as the water stood up like a wall on ★ both sides" (Exodus 14:29).

The lives of Noah, Joseph, and the Israelites remind us that "with God $\overset{}{\leftarrow}$ all things are possible" (Matthew 19:26). \bigstar
